Driving Directions

Mountain Lakes is located in the Fremont-Winema National Forest among the scenic cascades of Southern



Oregon. It is approximately 50 miles east of Medford and 30 miles west of Klamath Falls. If heading east on Hwy 140, before milepost #44, watch for

"Organization Camp" sign on left. Turn opposite sign onto graveled Varney Creek Road. Continue to camp about 1 1/2 miles. If you're heading west on Hwy 140, before milepost #43, watch for "Organization Camp" sign on the right. Turn opposite the sign to the left onto graveled Varney Creek Road. Continue to Camp as described above.
